#### Introduction: (Including Origin of the research problem..):

Introduction: Companies are responding to and would have to respond to society's demands for producing more socially responsible goods. Consumers across the world are increasingly concerned about the social and environmental impact of their purchase decisions. Choice between a fossil fuel car versus an electric vehicle, purchase of non-conflict diamonds, fair trade coffee etc., Today's marketers therefore cannot ignore this important and often influential group of consumers. Hence, there is a need to identify this set of consumers and profile their characteristics both demographically and psycho-graphically to serve them profitably.

Socially conscious consumption behavior is defined as "the perceived effect of consumer choice on social, environmental and safety matters" (Leigh, Murphy, & Enis, 1988, p5) or as striving to "protect and improve the social quality of life" (Davis, 1975, p 24). Ethical consumption behavior involves positive choice behaviors or negative consequence avoidance behavior usually with moral undertones." Morality is concerned with the norms, values and beliefs embedded in social processes which define right and wrong for an individual or community" Since ethical consumption is considered to be moral in nature, it should follow a moral decision making process (Caruana, 2007). Purchase decisions are often preceded by one s belief systems and attitudes. In this context it becomes important to study the antecedents of socially conscious consumption behavior of individuals or "ethical consumers". Personal values of individuals are one of the many influences on behavior. This study attempts to understand the values which affect the purchase decisions of this group of consumers. Values are considered to determine the goals and standards of behavior pursued by people. They serve as guiding principles in a person's life according to Rokeach (1973). Individuals learn values from the society and its institutions which in turn shape their more general beliefs and world view. Several research studies have shown the important role played by values in explaining people's attitude and activities(Dunlap, Grieneeks, and Rokeach; 1983, Rankin 1983; DeYoung 1985-86). Van Liere & Dunlap (1980) state that market segmentation in the context of environmental protection would greatly benefit from psychological studies correlating individuals's demographic characteristics, attitudes and personality studies.

#### Need for the study

The question that this research tries to address is to determine the role played by an individuals` personal value orientations in making socially conscious purchase decisions. In effect we would like to identify "ethical consumers" based on their value orientations. Understanding which underlying forces, situations and individual differences play a role in consumer decisions is an important step in fully understanding socially conscious consumer behavior. India with its rapidly growing economy and home to a huge middle class is an attractive destination for the world`s marketers. Consumption behavior has a cultural component and the Indian cultural ethos of emphasizing `voluntary simplicity` prompts us to believe that India might consist of large number of `ethical consumers`. Increasing education and awareness about environmental protection would also play an important role in making product choices. This study would be a small step in the direction of identifying and profiling the "ethical consumers".
